

## **Social Media Posting Guidelines & Disclaimer**

The intended purpose of the Old Town Police Department and Old Town Fire Rescue Facebook site is to serve as a means of communication between the City of Old Town Police and Fire Departments and members of the public. Therefore, information, posts, and comments containing any of the following forms of content shall not be allowed and will be removed from the site.

- Profane language or content
- Content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, religion, gender, marital status, familial status, national origin, age, mental or physical disability, sexual orientation, gender identity, source of income, or other protected status under applicable law
- Inappropriate sexual content or links to inappropriate sexual content
- Solicitations of commerce
- Conduct or encouragement of illegal activity
- Private and confidential information
- Information that may tend to compromise the safety and security of the public or public systems
- Content that violates a legal ownership interest of any other party
- Comments in support of or opposition to political campaigns or ballot measures
